



## UQFC Parent/Guardian ~ Code of Conduct

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*As a parent/guardian of a player/participant in any activity held by or under the auspices of UQFC, you are asked to meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct:*

- Remember that your child participates in sport for their own enjoyment, not yours.
- Focus on your child's efforts, development and performance rather than winning or losing.
- Never ridicule or yell at your child or other children for making a mistake.
- Show appreciation for good performance and skillful play by all players including the opposition.
- Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially when dealing with or in the vicinity of persons less than 18 years of age - your words and actions will set an example.
- Respect officials' decisions and teach the players to do likewise.
- Never physically or verbally abuse or harass anyone associated with the sport (player, coach, officials and administrators).
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Be a positive role model.
- Parents are not permitted on the pitch either during training or on game day.
- Parents are to use the designated spectator areas on game day and not be standing/seated in the vicinity of the player's technical area (dugout, player/coaches area)
- The relaying of technical instructions to individual players or the team as a whole - other than by the coaching staff – will not be permitted under any circumstances.
- Any concerns you might have should be discussed both in private and in a respectful manner, with the team manager.

***Breaches of this code of conduct may be referred to the UQFC Executive Committee and dealt with in accordance with the Club's constitution.***
